Travel by foot

The National Maritime Museum is only a 19-minute walk from Amsterdam Central Station. Follow Prins Hendrikkade east and you'll see our docked replica ship 'Amsterdam', on your left and Kattenburgerplein 1.



Travel by Amsterdam public transport

The Dutch National Maritime Museum is easy to reach by bus 22 (Muiderpoortstation). Bus 22 departs from Central Station Amsterdam bus station on IJzijde. The museum bus stop is slightly east of Amsterdam centre (Kadijksplein/Scheepvaartmuseum).

Tip: buy your Amsterdam Public Transport Ticket online for unlimited travel across Amsterdam, including Amsterdam centre.

And finally, the National Maritime Museum is really close to Amsterdam Central Station. From your train to Amsterdam, follow any of the suggestions above to get here quickly and easily.

Travel by bike

Bicycles are the most common transport of choice for many in Amsterdam, less than 5 minutes bicycle ride from Central Station to reach this part of the Amsterdam centre.

Travel by car

Travelling by car? Take the A10 ring road North, and exit S116 (IJ tunnel). There are four parking garages near the National Maritime Museum (Markenhoven, Oosterdok, Oostenburgereiland and De Loodsen).

Affordable parking

At P+R Zeeburg you can park cheaper if you travel by public transport. Take Tram 26 towards Central Station. It stops near the museum - stop Kattenburgerstraat. For more information about P+R Zeeburg, visit the website of the Municipality of Amsterdam. Streetparking is available but very limited.

Electric charging stations for the car can be found at Kattenburgerstraat 116 and Kadijksplein 18. Check the website of the Municipality of Amsterdam for more charging stations.
